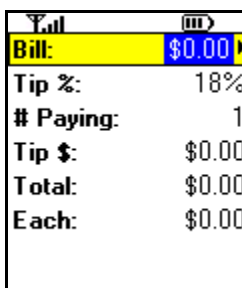


This walkthrough will get you started using your new tip calculator application, and will teach you about several of its features.

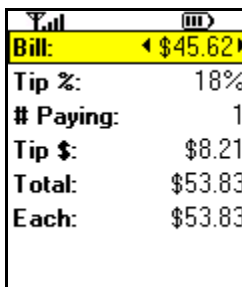
1. Start up your application on your phone. Each phone is different, so refer to your phone's user manual if you need help.
2. You'll see the following splash screen on your phone. You can press any key to skip the splash screen, or just wait 3 seconds.



3. You will then be presented with this screen, which lets you edit and view your current bill, total, and tip. (If you see other numbers, you've probably used the application before...just press **0** once to clear out the bill; the screenshots won't be exact but you'll be able to get an idea how it works anyway).



4. Type \$45.62 into the Bill field, by pressing **4**, **5**, **6**, and then **2**. You don't need to enter in a decimal point, as the calculator always makes two places for cents. Notice that you've already calculated your tip at the default 18%. The "Tip \$" field has the amount you should pay for the tip and the "Total" field says how much you should leave in total. If you make a mistake, press **clear** to erase the rightmost number (pressing clear when the value is \$0.00 will exit).



- Now lets change the tip. Press the **down** key to highlight the “Tip %” field. You can now press **left** or **right** to decrease or increase the tip by 1%. Notice that the “Tip \$” and “Total” fields are being recalculated on the fly. You can also type in the Tip % directly by using the number pad. Use either method to change the Tip % to 20%.

- Lets see how much each person owes if you were to split the bill with another person. Press **down** to highlight the “# Paying” field. Either use **left** or **right** to decrease or increase the number, or type it directly using the number pad. Use either method to set the number of people paying to 2. In the “Each” field, it now says how much each person should be paying if you split the bill evenly.

Bill:	\$45.62
Tip %:	20%
# Paying:	◀ 2 ▶
Tip \$:	\$9.12
Total:	\$54.74
Each:	\$27.37

- To make it easier to pay, you can quickly round values to the nearest quarter (\$0.25). Press **down** until the “Each” field is highlighted. Pressing left and right will decrease and increase the amount by a quarter, rounding to the nearest quarter. You can also round the “Bill”, “Total”, and “Tip \$” fields. Round the “Each” field to \$27.00. You can see the Tip %, Tip \$, and Total have been automatically adjusted to use your desired value.

8. Close the application by pressing the **end** (or hang-up) key on your phone. The values you just entered are saved on your phone. The next time you start up the application, you'll be able to review what you just paid. This also means you'll keep your desired tip percentage as a default.
9. Restart the application and review that the screen shows the same values you just entered.

10. Type in \$97.44 as a new value for the Bill. Notice that the old bill was erased as soon as you pressed **9**. You don't have to clear out the old value; you can just start typing the new value right away.
